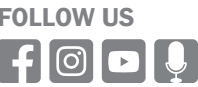

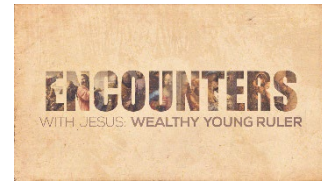

Next Steps: Home-Group Study and/or Personal Discipleship Guide

Mk. 10:17-31

Get together as a family or with a friend or group of friends this week!

Start with Prayer -ask Jesus to guide our time together. Go over prayer requests together.

Read the Text – Mark 10:17-31

Questions for Reflection & Discussion:

1. Compare and contrast how the rich young ruler was and was not like a child.
2. Why did Jesus begin to answer the man's question by guiding him towards a proper understanding of, "good"?
3. What was it about Jesus' response that left the rich young man sorrowful? What was this man placing his hope and security in? (20-22) How was Jesus' invitation a call for repentance?
4. How did Jesus' disciples respond to this encounter? What seemed so impossible to them? (23-27)
5. What did Jesus promise to faithful disciples? (28-31) How does verse 31 reveal the upside-down nature of the Kingdom of God? How is what Jesus rewards different from what the world rewards?

Questions guiding Spiritual Formation & Application:

1. How does this text invite us to grow in a greater love for God?
2. What lessons within this text move us towards growing in our love for one another?
3. What principles could be applied to our family life, careers, communities, or congregational life?
4. Consider how Jesus could use our application of the principles in this text to draw those that do not know him, unto himself?
5. Who is currently in our lives that needs an invitation to meet Jesus or be part of a kind and gracious Christian community?
