May God continue to bless you, dear brothers and sisters. Receive warm greetings from Guayama, Puerto Rico. We want to share with you what God has been doing during these past four months.

Every year in February, we organize a Friendship Day activity with an evangelistic purpose. The brothers invite their relatives,

neighbors, and friends to hear the gospel message. Thank God, four families visited us that day.

In March, we took a trip and were blessed to visit Emmanuel Baptist Church in Atlanta, Georgia, for the second time. Mauricio had the opportunity to participate in the sermon and received the pleasant surprise of being included in their missions program.

In April, we had the great blessing of attending a retreat for pastoral families organized by a missionary group in Wisconsin. It was a time of great joy and encouragement as we received the teachings and fellowship with other pastoral families. In commemoration of God's great love, which was to send his Son to die for us, during Holy Week we had a time to reflect, draw closer to God, and remember the center of our faith through fasting and prayer.
