Missionary Danny Araya has just shared with me a very special request. They are recuperating from the sudden passing of his father, Jorge, and Danny and his family have moved in with his mother, Giselle, to comfort her and be there for her for any assistance she might need. Since the Araya families live in houses on their own enclosed property, the move is just a stone's throw away. However, there is a need to make adjustments involving electrical work, expansion, and other things to rearrange to an extent the living environment for Danny, Cindy, and the children - Sofia, and Pablo.

Bro. Danny has calculated the need to come to \$5000. If you support Bro. Danny's ministry, or if you know him and are familiar with his work in Costa Rica, you may feel led by the Lord to make a sacrifice and help this dear brother with this need. Danny is a very special servant of God who knows no stranger and continually sacrifices to help others when they are in need. His ministry has many facets in which he uses the gifts and talents that God has given him to further the work of the gospel and train new believers for future missionary work. His ability to solve problems with computers, cell phones, video and sound equipment, etc. is second to none which has been such a blessing and help to the Coronado church ministry and to many other servants of God involved in missionary work (and to me personally). Danny's family has not only recently suffered the loss of his father, but for the last year has had to deal with the ongoing low-red-blood-cell-count problem of his 12-year-old son Pablo (turns 13 in July). This has resulted in many blood transfusions and many attempts to find the cause of the irregularity. The specialists have finally narrowed it down to a problem with the bone marrow. They say there are two possibilities: one is that the bone marrow is being affected by a disorder that can be treated, and the other possibility is that Pablo would need a bone marrow transplant. The best candidate for a donor would be his 16-year-old sister, Sofia. Please continue to pray for Pablo, that God will extend his never-ending mercy and healing touch to this precious son.
