Revelation 10:1-11

Revelation: The Last Word (Chapters 6-13) Part 7

1. Stand firm on _____ because it comes with divine power

Then I saw another mighty angel coming down from heaven. He was robed in a cloud, with a rainbow above his head; his face was like the sun, and his legs were like fiery pillars. He was holding a little scroll, which lay open in his hand. He planted his right foot on the sea and his left foot on the land, and he gave a loud shout like the roar of a lion. When he shouted, the voices of the seven thunders spoke. – **Revelation 10:1-3 NIV**

God has never said to any of the angels, “You are my Son, because today I have become your Father!” Neither has God said to any of them, “I will be his Father, and he will be my Son!” When God brings his first-born Son into the world, he commands all of his angels to worship him. – **Hebrews 1:5-6 CEV**

There’s nothing like the written Word of God for showing you the way to salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. Every part of Scripture is God-breathed and useful one way or another—showing us truth, exposing our rebellion, correcting our mistakes, training us to live God’s way. Through the Word we are put together and shaped up for the tasks God has for us. – **2 Timothy 3:15-17 MSG**

2. Be _____ because God’s clock is ticking

Then the angel I had seen standing on the sea and on the land raised his right hand to heaven. And he swore by him who lives for ever and ever, who created the heavens and all that is in them, the earth and all that is in it, and the sea and all that is in it, and said, “There will be no more delay! – **Revelation 10:5-6 NIV**

Be patient and stand firm, because the Lord’s coming is near. Don’t grumble against one another, brothers and sisters, or you will be judged. The Judge is standing at the door! – **James 5:8-9 NIV**

All of us must quickly carry out the tasks assigned us by the one who sent me, for there is little time left before the night falls and all work comes to an end. – **John 9:4 LB**

3. Embrace the _____ and bitterness of the Gospel

Then the voice that I had heard from heaven spoke to me once more: “Go, take the scroll that lies open in the hand of the angel who is standing on the sea and on the land.” So I went to the angel and asked him to give me the little scroll. He said to me, “Take it and eat it. It will turn your stomach sour, but ‘in your mouth it will be as sweet as honey.’” – **Revelation 10:8-9 NIV**

When your words came, I ate them; they were my joy and my heart’s delight, for I bear your name, Lord God Almighty. – **Jeremiah 15:16 NIV**

Your teachings are sweeter than honey. – **Psalms 119:103 CEV**

I took the little scroll from the angel’s hand and ate it. It tasted as sweet as honey in my mouth, but when I had eaten it, my stomach turned sour. – **Revelation 10:10 NIV**

God’s word is alive and powerful! It is sharper than any double-edged sword. His word can cut through our spirits and souls and through our joints and marrow, until it discovers the desires and thoughts of our hearts. – **Hebrews 4:12 CEV**

4. Keep _____ the Word until the end

Then I was told, “You must prophesy again about many peoples, nations, languages and kings.” – **Revelation 10:11 NIV**
