



MESSAGE ACTION PLAN

“The Kingdom Is Coming”

Revelation 11:15-19

Monday – The Trumpet Resounds (Read Rev 11:15; Dan 7:13-14)

1. What does the announcement in Rev. 11:15 tell you about the certainty of Jesus’ reign?
2. How does knowing Jesus will reign forever impact how you handle today’s uncertainties?

ACTION: Spend 10 minutes today in prayer, praising God for His unshakable Kingdom. Declare your trust in Jesus as your eternal King.

Tuesday – Heaven’s Response (Read Rev 11:16-17; Ps 97:1-6)

1. Who do the elders respond to God’s reign with worship and thanksgiving?
2. What area of your life needs to reflect more gratitude for God’s sovereign rule?

ACTION: Write down three specific things you can thank God for today that reflect His rule in your life. Offer a prayer of thanksgiving before bedtime.

Wednesday – Wrath and Justice (Read Rev. 11:18a; Rom 2:1-11)

1. Why is God’s wrath a necessary part of His justice?
2. Do you ever struggle with reconciling God’s love and His judgment? Why?

ACTION: Examine your heart for any ongoing sin or area of rebellion. Confess it to God today, asking Him to purify your heart and prepare you for His Kingdom.

Thursday – Rewards and Responsibility (Rev 11:18b; 2 Cor 5:10; Heb 6:10)

1. What motivates you more—fear of judgment or hope of reward? Why?
2. In what ways are you faithfully serving God today?

ACTION: Identify one way you can serve someone selflessly today. Do it as an act of worship to your coming King.

Friday – The Temple Roars (Read Rev 11:19; Ex 19:16-19)

1. What does the thunder and lightning around the temple reveal about God’s power and holiness?
2. How does God’s open temple encourage you in your faith walk today?

ACTION: Set aside 10 minutes in silence and solitude to reflect on the holiness of God. Ask Him to help you live in reverence and readiness for His Kingdom.
