The Text:

- 1.) All Nations Are Marked By One Defining Characteristic, They Do Not Pursue Righteousness.
- 2.) Paul Tells Us Those Who Did Not Pursue Righteousness Have Attained.

Two Things To Remember To Help Us Understand the Text:

- 1.) We Need to Remember the Christian Gospel.
 - The Christian Gospel is Not Something You <u>Do</u> For God, But Something God <u>Does</u> For You
- 2.) We Need to Ask Why is This Here?
 - Because of Four Prophecies that Show Us God Had Always Planned to Save <u>More</u> Gentiles than Expected and <u>Less</u> Jews Than Expected

Read Romans 9:24-29

Romans 9:6, "...For they are not all Israel who are of Israel"

- 1.) One of the Great <u>Discouragements</u> in Evangelism is People Aren't Interested, But it Doesn't <u>Matter</u>, God Saves Gentiles Anyways.
 - 1 Corinthians 6:9-11, "**9** Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals,

nor sodomites, **10** nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God. **11** And such were some of you...
