## *A word from Pastor Justin*

Mt. Pisgah family,

A few weeks ago, our church kicked off the start of summer with an outdoor worship service in our pavilion. There was so much vibrancy in the air as we worshiped with our contemporary band, celebrated Father's Day with a cookout, and felt the warmth of the Holy Spirit (or possibly the hot sun) as our community came together.

As we move into the season of Pentecost, I'm reminded of the story from Acts 2 about a community of believers in Christ who come together to worship God. Suddenly, each of them is filled with the Holy Spirit and able to speak in different languages as the Spirit gave them ability. As the people in Acts 2 looked around and knew something special was happening right in front of their eyes, it's obvious that the Holy Spirit is still active today. We rejoice in all the blessings God has provided for this community and look forward to what God has in store for the rest of the summer. May the Holy Spirit continue to set our hearts ablaze with joy as we uplift the kingdom of God together.

Join us Wednesday nights in August for fellowship, fun, and a little friendly competition at our Pickleball Ministry gatherings!



## Treasury Report for July/August 2025



## Financial Update

6/20/2025

As we close out our current Fiscal year we continue to be in excellent financial shape. In summary: despite lower than budgeted Income this year, expenses were even lower; we carry no debt; our Reserve Fund has a healthy balance of \$107,888; and our building and grounds are extremely well maintained. God has truly blessed us as you have in sharing your gifts.

After 11 months of this fiscal year our Income is \$397,735 which is 11% below budget. Expenses are \$378,619 which is 15% below budget. So, despite being below our annual budget of \$483,280, we have spent \$17,116 less than we received. As noted above, our Reserve Fund is healthy, and the balance has grown \$21,435 this year.

During our May Congregational meeting we voted and passed a budget for 2025/2026 of \$456,226. Although lower than this year's budget it does represent growth over where we will finish our current year. Your kindness and generosity will enable us to do great things, and I am confident God will continue to provide all we need.

During my time as Treasurer I have always been impressed with the gifts of skilled work that members so openly share within our church. Your work and the resulting savings are a major contributor to our financial well-being. To all of you, I say thank you!
