

John 1-10 Series Summary

April 27 – June 29, 2025



- **John 1 – “Light” (4/27/25)**
 - **KEY THOUGHT:** Jesus was the Light who came into the darkness to call, rescue, and reveal Himself to His followers in forever life-transforming ways.

- **John 2 – “Wine” (5/4/25)**
 - **KEY THOUGHT:** When we’re all out of wine and at the end of our rope desperate, Jesus (the true “life of the party”) rescues us and restores the joy of His salvation.

- **John 3 – “Believe” (5/11/25)**
 - **KEY THOUGHT:** When you believe in Christ, you will live forever.

- **John 4 – “Water” (5/18/25)**
 - **KEY THOUGHT:** Intense thirst isn’t a bad thing if it’s what leads you to the greatest source of refreshment your soul can ever know... Jesus.

- **John 5 – “Pool” (5/25/25)**
 - **KEY THOUGHT:** Jesus is the ultimate source of our help and needs.

- **John 6 – “Bread” (6/1/25)**
 - **KEY THOUGHT:** I can’t, but He can. (You are what you eat, and you live what you believe.)

- **John 7 – “Thirsty” (6/8/25)**
 - **KEY THOUGHT:** Jesus is the ultimate satisfaction for our thirsty souls.

- **John 8 – “I Am” (6/15/25)**
 - **KEY THOUGHT:** Knowing who Jesus is (love, light, Son of God, and God) directly impacts our ability to know God and be known by God.

- **John 9 – “Sight” (6/22/25)**
 - **KEY THOUGHT:** Jesus opened the eyes of a blind man, but he also wants to open the eyes of our hearts so that we can see his plans for our lives.

- **John 10 – “Shepherd” (6/29/25)**
 - **KEY THOUGHT:** Jesus is the fork in the road of life and death. Life satisfaction and eternal security are directly related to what we believe about Jesus.
