

Celebrating 25 Years of Calvary Kids: August 24th





SCRIPTURE LESSON Ephesians 6:10-20 (NIV)

"A.L.I.V.E. - In the Armor of God"

Series – Ephesians: A.L.I.V.E. in Christ Rev. Randall G. Bennett, Jr. June 29, 2025

Background to Ephesians: The Apostle Paul arrived in Ephesus in A.D. 52 and evangelized there for two years (Acts 19:10). Paul performed numerous miracles during this time (Acts 19:11-12), demonstrating the power of Jesus' name over demon possession (Acts 19:13-16), magic practices (Acts 19:17-19), and the worship of Artemis (Acts 19:23 -41). As a result, "the word of the Lord grew in power" (Acts 19:20). When Paul departed, he left behind a thriving and healthy church, as noted in Acts 20:16-38 during his journey to Jerusalem.

Theme - Counter-Cultural: How does the Church overcome the influence of the culture surrounding her? Paul's answer is clear: through the immeasurable power of the Living God, the Church can live in the culture but not of the culture by embracing God's grace as the source of their identity and power.

Literary Structure: This letter is structured into two main sections. Chapters 1-3 focus on Orthodoxy (thinking aligned with God's Kingdom). Chapters 4-6 focus on Orthopraxy (behavior aligned with God's Kingdom).

Series Acronym

Awakened by Grace Living in Unity Identified with Christ Victorious through His Power Equipped to Witness

Today's Sermon: Paul concludes his letter by drawing upon the imagery of a Roman Soldier's armor. Our struggle, Paul emphasizes, is not with people but with the unseen spiritual forces of evil that seek to undermine God's Kingdom. The Armor of God protects our souls against evil and equips us to carry the light of Jesus into the darkness.

- Our War: We don't fight flesh and blood, but dark spiritual powers.
- Our Battle Cry: Be strong in the Lord and stand firm!
- Our Armor: Truth, righteousness, peace, faith, salvation, and the Sword of the Spirit are essential for both protection and proclamation.
- Our Battlefield: Prayer is our lifeline in the realms of the seen and unseen. It bridges both realms with directed energy to God and from God.
