


## The Pastor Will Be Away

- Dan moved to approve the minutes of the May 19 Council Meeting. Jay seconded the motion and it carried.
- Becky presented the treasurer's report through May 31.
- Committee reports were reviewed. The trustees received a letter from a member regarding painting the lectern at the Hollandale site. This is referred back to the trustees to make a decision.
- Pastor gave his report. He will be officiating at a wedding at the Blanchardville site on September 13 with a rehearsal on Friday, the 12th. Hollandale Homecoming is scheduled for September 6 and the Women's group will be serving a dinner as in previous years. He will be a Synod representative to the Churchwide Assembly in Phoenix the last week in July. The Assembly will be electing a new bishop and secretary of the ELCA. He will also be attending a Continuing Education course, The Moses Project, in Des Moines, Iowa, the first week of August. He is planning to visit all of the nursing homes where we have residents residing this week.
- Thank you notes were received from the recipients of the Helping Hands scholarship fund.
- There were no transfers or new members to approve.

#### No New Business

#### **Old Business:**

- Chuck Meyer reported on the progress of the Capital Project. The awning on the parking lot side has been replaced and will need to be shingled. The soffit on the south peak is completed and the east side is being worked on. Dave Gerber and Neal Klassy have been helping with the project. In inspecting the brick work, the tuck pointing needs replacing and the bats need to be eliminated. Thus far, the projects (boiler and fellowship floor) have totaled \$71,000 of the \$150,000 approved by the congregation.
- Judy reported on the Anniversary Celebration. Dawn Doran and Marlys Hittesdorf are organizing. The food will be obtained locally. Woodford State Bank is paying for all of the paper products. Marlys and Judy will be meeting with Michele to organize the picture directory. Marie Leafblad, Associate to the Bishop, will attend from the Synod office.
