Thursday, July 10 We pray that God will guide us in truth and teach us.

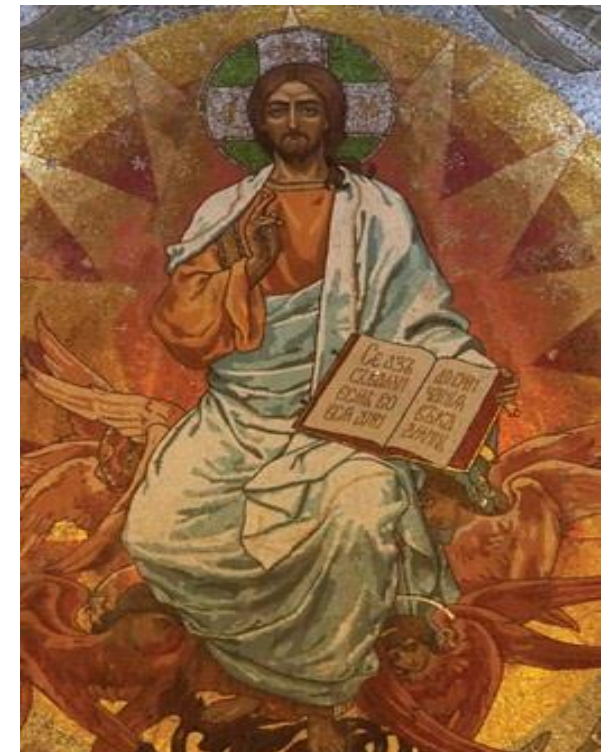
Friday, July 11 We pray for ministers on sick leave, especially those on long-term disability, that they may know the presence of our loving God and the support of caring people in their lives.
