## BIBLE STUDY LESSON #8 RELATING TO PEOPLE

Because of your new relationship with God, you will have a whole new relationship with people. Being a Christian is not something you do only once a week or when no one is watching; it affects every aspect of your life. The Lord is very concerned about your involvement with people. Let us look in the Scriptures to see how God views us.

We see, then, that there are two aspects to our dealings with people. First, there are the other members of God's family with whom we interact. We will call this aspect "fellowship". Second, there are the unbelievers to whom we proclaim God's message. We will refer to this aspect as "witnessing."

The word "fellowship" means sharing something with another person in a profound way. We share in the life of God and Christ (who are one).
