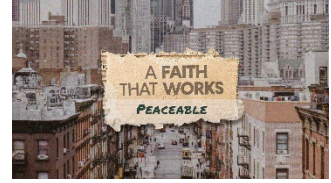

<p style="text-align: center;">Get together as a family or with a friend or group of friends this week!</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Start with <u>Prayer</u> -ask Jesus to guide our time together. Go over prayer requests together.</p> <p><b><u>Read the Text</u></b> – James 3:13-18</p> <p><b><u>Questions for Reflection &amp; Discussion:</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Begin this week's reflection and discussion time by selecting 3 wisdom scriptures from the right column. Silently read the 3 scriptures you selected, then either journal your takeaways, or share your takeaways with the group.</li> <li>2. How does James describe the way that those who are wise among us will conduct themselves? (vs. 13)</li> <li>3. What are the qualities of, "not wisdom?" (vss. 14-16) Where does jealousy and selfish ambition exist in our own lives? How about within our communities? Share practical ways that we can identify and avoid these negative qualities.</li> <li>4. In verse 17 James describes the qualities of wisdom that comes from above. Name each quality, then reflect on or journal about which of these qualities most resonate with you. How do we see these qualities of wisdom come to life in the earthly ministry of Jesus?</li> <li>5. As James concludes his instruction on wisdom, he cites that "a harvest righteousness will be sown in peace by those who cultivate (make) peace." Discuss ways in which we as individuals and communities can both sow peace, and cultivate peace? What does it look like to sow and cultivate peace in our personal lives? What might it look like to do so within our Christian communities?</li> </ol> <p><b><u>Questions guiding Spiritual Formation &amp; Application:</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. How does this text invite us to grow in a greater love for God?</li> <li>2. What lessons within this text move us towards growing in our love for one another?</li> <li>3. Consider how Jesus could use our application of the principles in this text to draw those that do not know him, unto himself?</li> <li>5.
