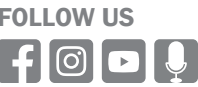

Go over prayer requests together.</p> <p><u>Read the Text</u> – James 5:7-12</p> <p><u>Questions for Reflection & Discussion:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How does James use his words in verses 7-12 to speak to both the wealthy and the economically disadvantaged within his congregation? 2. What is the hope that is to help form and grow patience within the Christian congregation (vss.7-8)? Journal about or discuss how this hope has nurtured the growth of patience in your own journey. 3. How does grumbling or complaining against one another work against the formation and application of patience both within the congregation, and within our daily lives? (vs. 9) 4. Journal or discuss the examples that James offers as faithful illustrations of patience and suffering. Who are they? How does their testimony speak to their faithfulness in suffering? (vss. 10-11) 5. Placing verse 12 in the context of patience in suffering, what does this verse teach us about the evidence of patience?
