How does hearing diverse stories like these help shape your view of who baptism is for?

5. What does it mean for you to be “all in” with Jesus?

Is there any part of your life where Jesus is inviting you to trust or surrender more deeply?

6. For those already baptized:

How can you “remember your baptism” in practical ways—especially in seasons when your faith feels dry or routine?

7. For those considering baptism:

What might be holding you back? What step would help you move closer to saying “yes” to this outward symbol of your faith?
