





May 16-18 we made the 2-hour trip up the coast to llo to preach and teach at a Family Conference at Iglesia Bautista Peniel, where Samuel Huaman is pastor. We thank the Lord for our van, so that the whole family could travel comfortably, and also that we didn't have any mechanical issues along the way.

It has been a joy to share basic Bible truths about God and His Word, starting in Genesis, in our dining room on a weekly basis! This is Ben's first opportunity to teach in the Romanian language, and we covet your prayers for clarity. After the third week's lesson, one of the young ladies said she was amazed at how much we can learn about God just from Genesis chapter 1! Please

This required a Romanian birth certificate and a US Passport. Once those were in hand, our Romanian contact, Adi, helped us gather up all of the other documents to apply



"God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore will not we fear, though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea; Though the waters thereof roar and be troubled, though the mountains shake with the swelling thereof. Selah. There is a river, the streams whereof shall make glad the city of God, the holy place of the tabernacles of the most High. God is in the midst of her; she shall not be moved: God shall help her, and that right early." - Psalm 46:1-5

Today as our prayers are being sent Heavenward our thoughts are directed toward a county in rural Texas. The attention of people around the world has been focused there since the news began coming in concerning the tragedy that impacted Kerrville, Texas. As the details continue to immerge, our hearts are filled with grief and countless questions. Even now, the church that I am privileged to pastor is preparing to send several of our teens to a week of summer camp; just as families in Texas had done.

And yet now, the lives of dozens of families have been torn apart by a disaster that no parent, no person, no camp director should ever have to face. I wonder how many parents have already purchased new clothes and supplies for the upcoming school year for their daughter. I have thought of those who have made plans for a trip before the end of summer. But suddenly everything has changed. Families that were looking forward to spending time together are now preparing for funerals and their lives will never again be the same.

Sometimes it takes something like this to put everything into its proper perspective; to make us realize that it is not about school calendars and sports schedules, new clothes and last-minute vacations. Such an occurrence even causes us to ask some very difficult questions. I want to attempt to answer one of those tough questions. What happens when a child dies?

King David said, upon the passing of his infant son, "... Can I bring him back again? I shall go to him, but he shall not return to me." - Il Samuel 12:23. David, a man after God's own heart, certainly went to Heaven when he died and he was certain he would again see his little son who had just passed into glory!

There is further Biblical truth that gives insight as well. Paul said, "... for by the law is the knowledge of sin" - Romans 3:20. The law of God, in other words the "thou shalts" and the "thou shalt nots," tell us what is wrong and what is right and that we have sinned and come short of God's glory. Romans 3:10 and Romans 3:23 bear this out clearly.

If a child has not come to the knowledge of sin, they are not accountable. We must embrace foundational truth concerning salvation. In this world a person is either lost, saved, or safe. Let me explain. You are lost if you know the difference between right and wrong and have not come to Jesus for salvation. You are saved if you have the understanding of right and wrong and have come to Jesus. But a child who dies before reaching the age of accountability is safe in the arms of Jesus.

Every child I have talked to about Jesus is very sensitive and positive toward the things of God. I was telling someone recently, a child is willing to believe; they must be taught to be skeptics. I am convinced more than ever that God is willing to extend His broad plan of salvation to especially include a young-ster. Jesus loves the children of the world: "But Jesus said, Suffer little children, and forbid them not, to come unto me: for of such is the kingdom of heaven" - Matthew 19:14

In the fleeting moments before those precious girls in Texas breathed their last breath, God may have revealed Jesus in a very precious way to them. Truly, only eternity will reveal what happened in those frantic moments when flood waters rushed towards cabins filled with children.

Some have speculated that in special ways, angels hover just a little closer to the atmosphere of children. We do not know this for sure, but what we are sure of is that we do have guardian angels and they are known to watch over the "little ones": "Take heed that ye despise not one of these little ones; for I say unto you, That in heaven their angels do always behold the face of my Father which is in heaven" - Matthew 18:10

When departure from this world to heaven takes place, we are assured that just like Lazarus, Jesus tells us, "And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom..." - Luke 16:22.

Amid all our questions and uncertainty, there is the understanding that God was, is, and always shall be in control. The Almighty, Omniscient, Omnipotent God is sovereign and knows things we do not know. Therefore, let's trust Him to convert even this catastrophe into something of redeeming value.

But what about you, and what will happen when you die? Today you still have a choice to make. Today is the day of salvation and now is the accepted time. I strongly encourage you to accept Jesus as your only way to go to Heaven before it is too late.
