Rocky Mountain Synod Assembly Report-2025

The Synod Assembly was held on May 22-24 in Albuquerque New Mexico. The theme of the assembly was "Dios esta aqui" (God is here). As your congregational representative, Howard & I were able to get a much better sense of the large region covered by our synod staff from the Denver office; the area covers Wyoming, Utah, Colorado, New Mexico & our El Paso area. Bishop Meghan Johnston-Aelabouni & her staff are looking into a new office facility in a much safer part of Denver. She also has proposed that she & her staff travel to cities & spend perhaps a week assisting those churches with their local needs.

Bishop Meghan in her first 10 months as our new bishop has made changes in the staff & their assignments to better serve the needs of churches. Staff have prepared training materials & workshops-some on Zoom-to address the shortage of called & ordained ministers. These are available for lay people who are leading worship & activities in their congregations. At a workshop on congregational lay ministry teams, lay leaders shared the innovative ways that they are using to share ministry duties in their churches without ordained ministers. Staff are available for support & equip their efforts to continue to keep their churches open for worship, fellowship & potential growth.

The voting members at the assembly voted to fill positions on the Synod Council & on committees & for various business matters. Vicar Thania Drake was elected to serve on the nominating committee. Several resolutions regarding "Honoring Indigenous People through Faith, Respect & Action", "Renewing Our Welcome: Strengthening Our Reconciled in Christ Commitment" & "Campus Ministry" were passed by the assembly. The synod budget & giving by each congregation was printed in the assembly hand book for review.

A concern for the Bishop & staff is the status of properties owned by the synod. In addition to the need for a new office space, the staff & council are looking into what to do with a retreat facility which is not being utilized & the cost of upkeep.

Bishop Meghan & her staff are open to innovative, forward-thinking ways to assist congregations in the synod to maintain & enrich worship as we look to the future. Her vision is to "relate, support, connect, & equip the people & ministries of the synod" so everyone may encounter Jesus. "Dios esta aqui"-God is certainly here.

Thank you for the opportunity to attend the synod assembly as representatives for New Hope. It was an opportunity to get to know the Bishop & her staff & realize the resources available for us to enrich our ministry to El Paso.

We would recommend that at the next congregational meeting that a change be made in our constitution to reflect the need to cover the cost of travel. Travel costs are now excluded for reimbursement in the constitution. The budget for synod expenses would also need to be adjusted. In the past the synod provided assistance with travel costs.

## **THRIVENT**

Thrivent Choice "Make a Personal Donation" Maybe you have heard it said many times "follow the prompts" to make a personal donation and have no clue what that actually means or how it works! So here's a little cheat sheet, I did some exploring to figure it out.

First of all, you don't have to be a Thrivent member to use this feature.

Second, it's a way to give via your credit card and rack up more points or miles and the organization (New Hope or someplace else) will get a record of your personal donation and should track that gift for you in the same way as if you had put a check in an envelope, it should be recorded by them for you

Third of all this is DIFFERENT than designating Thrivent Choice dollars for those of you who are Thrivent members
Fourth, it's not so easy as just having a link which is specific to New Hope, maybe we will do that in time, for now below is a cheat sheet to help you if you want to use the Thrivent choice personal donation system

- 1. go to thrivent.com
- 2. search box type in "thrivent choice"
- 3. once in thrivent choice click on "make a personal donation"
- 4. follow remaining prompts which are self explanatory
