If there's one lesson we can take from today's readings it's that our faith is simple. Jesus patiently fields these Jesuitical questions from a lawyer cross-examining him about the two great commandments: love God and love your neighbour as yourself. It doesn't get much clearer than that. But Jesus goes on to tell a long story to underline this point: stop for everyone. It's that simple. The Good Samaritan is the only one in Jesus' story who is honouring his instincts: the commandment written not just on stone tablets or in a book in the clouds, but on our hearts.
