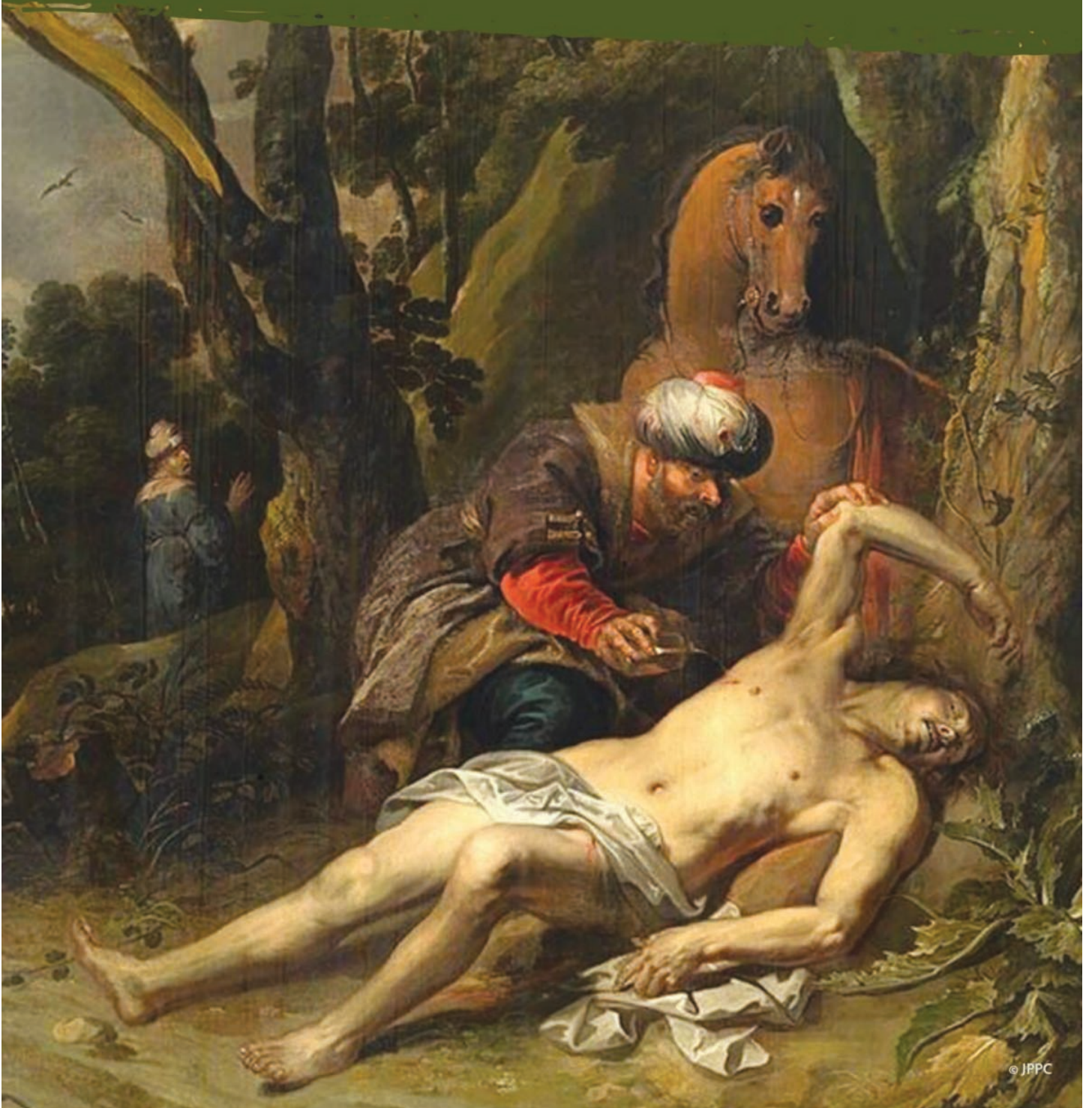

**SPN Parish Council Holy Moment Thought...**  
**“MY PEACE I GIVE TO YOU.”**

Jesus said to his disciples: “Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid. (John 14: 27). Jesus gives a special peace, the Shalom, to His disciples and to us present-day disciples.

This is the Peace of Christ. It is radically different from the peace of the world. The world claims peace when there is no war, when the stock market and the economy are good. When the family is not at each other's throat, or everyone is in good health. The peace of Jesus is unlike Pax Romana, the imposed peace of the Roman Empire on conquered people. It is the Peace through the strength of Jesus.

What is the peace that Jesus Christ gives us? What is His special type of peace? When one experiences the fullness of the Peace of Christ, he or she becomes able to withstand the hardships of this world *without fear*. The martyrs, who felt immense joy and peace at the moment of their execution serve as a stunning and tangible example of this Peace of Christ in action. The apostles Paul and Barnabas “strengthened the spirits of the disciples and exhorted them to persevere in the faith, saying, ‘It is necessary for us to undergo many hardships to enter the Kingdom of God.’ ” (Acts 14: 22). Saint Padre Pio shared his motto, “Pray, hope and don’t worry”.

How do we accept this peace? It is our task to *receive* this Peace of Christ...accept it...cultivate it...understand it...grow it and most importantly, as a true believer, to share it with others. We are called to comfort all who are living with a worldly view of peace; one that allows huge burdens of distress when worldly peace is disrupted or distant from us. Even in the sporadic moments of temporary worldly peace, we feel the tenuousness and anticipate the loss of this kind of peace.

**Not so with the blessed Peace of Christ, this is a special gift of the Holy Spirit!** When the Holy Spirit takes residence in your heart, He brings the Peace of Christ. The Holy Spirit brings love, joy, patience and other sweet gifts to those who believe and accept the Peace of Christ!

Please consider saying the following prayer...**O merciful God, fill our hearts, we pray, with the graces of your Holy Spirit; with love, joy, peace, patience, gentleness, goodness, faithfulness, humility and self-control. Teach us to love those who hate us; to pray for those who despitefully use us; that we may be the children of your love, our Father, who makes the sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust.**

# Chairman's Statement on *Dobbs* Anniversary

## USCCB Committee on Pro-Life Activities

June 24, 2025, marks the third anniversary of the Supreme Court's decision in *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization*, which overturned *Roe v. Wade* and ended nearly fifty years of virtually unlimited, nationwide abortion. Hope had never been lost in God's power to right that wrong and accomplish what the world believed to be impossible. During this Jubilee Year of Hope, we are called to reflect more deeply on the enduring hope that has been won for us through the death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.

The *Dobbs* decision not only gave states the freedom to protect preborn children but also paved the way for pro-life victories nationally. The federal government is now closer than ever to defunding Planned Parenthood and other organizations whose abortion profiteering harms women and babies.

At the same time, we know that several states have enacted extreme pro-abortion policies, overriding existing pro-life safeguards, with some states leaving children vulnerable to abortion even up to birth. Despite the good that *Dobbs* decision accomplished, the battle for life is far from over. I urge all Catholics to [engage their elected officials](#) on all issues that threaten the gift of human life, in particular the threat of abortion.

As we confront the challenges of our time, let us find hope anew in this Jubilee Year and be strengthened in our resolve to serve the cause of life. May our Catholic parishes continue to welcome, embrace, and accompany women facing unexpected or challenging



pregnancies through initiatives like [Walking with Moms in Need](#). And may we never tire of sharing Christ's message of mercy with all who are suffering in the aftermath of an abortion through ministries like [Project Rachel](#).

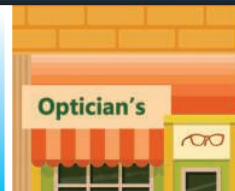

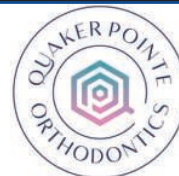
