Good Work

As I write this article, I'm sitting in the airport in St. Louis waiting on my (twice delayed) flight home from the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship General Assembly. My heart is full after three days of worship, learning, and connecting with friends old and new. This year's General Assembly theme was "You Belong Here." I am grateful to be part of a fellowship that is working to be a place of belonging, where everyone is welcome. We spent the week reflecting on what radical hospitality can look like. We celebrated the work of missionaries, some of whom have been in the same place for 10, 20, and even 30 years, sharing God's love and sharing life with their neighbors in Danville, in Thailand, in Eastern North Carolina, and around the world. We commissioned 11 chaplains and pastoral counselors to serve in hospitals, hospices, and the military. We heard sermons that challenged us to stand for the oppressed and to rely on Jesus as our foundation, our focus, and our center. I attended workshops on being a generous congregation and on moving from compassion to action in ending hunger. I was inspired by other churches doing creative things to live into God's mission for their congregations and uplifted by conversations around meals at the Racial Justice and Baptist Women in Ministry lunches. Good things are happening with the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship, and I am proud that Radiance has chosen to be part of that good work!

We have good work to be about right here in our community, too! This month, we've invited Colonial Presbyterian Church, Grandin Court Baptist, and other local congregations to join us in a week of loving our neighbors, focused particularly on food insecurity and hunger. The Ministries Council has planned a great week for us. All the details are in this newsletter, and I hope you will plan to be part of at least one activity. As Revelation 7:16 promises, when God's kingdom comes fully, "Never again will they hunger; never again will they thirst." Until that time, let's do our part to bring God's kingdom on earth as it is in heaven, by meeting the needs we see around us.
