ELDER COMMITTEE VACANCIES

The Risk Management Committee and Stewardship Committee both have vacancies and are offering the opportunity for members to nominate suitable candidates. Nominees should uphold the biblical qualifications of a deacon and be a Member of NLCC in good standing (Romans 16:1, 1 Timothy 3:8-13, Acts 6:3).

Risk Management Committee responsibilities:

- Biennial review of the Constitution, Bylaws, Operating Policies, and other policies of NLCC
- Review of NLCC's liability insurance coverage
- Ensure staff compliance with risk management procedures including security and safety
- Oversee the development of improved risk management procedures
- Ensure compliance with all regulatory requirements and implementation of best practices recommended by denominational leadership and the Canadian Council of Christian Charities
- This committee meets approximately 3 times per year

Stewardship Committee responsibilities:

- Oversee the development of the annual budget(s) of the church
- Determine fiscal policies and oversee their application for NLCC's ministries and operations ensuring that compliance with CRA regulations is maintained
- Ensure that biblical principles of stewardship and giving are taught and encouraged
- Identify and oversee financial strategies for funding capital projects, mission projects, and various other special projects as directed by the Elders
- Review financial reports and make recommendations to the Elders for action as required
- This committee meets monthly, primarily during workday hours
