### The Heidelberg Catechism

**Question 108 - What does the seventh commandment teach us?** A - That all unchastity is cursed by God. We must therefore detest it from the heart and live chaste and disciplined lives, both within and outside of holy marriage.

**Question 109 - Does God in this commandment forbid nothing more than adultery and similar shameful sins?** A - Since we, body and soul, are temples of the Holy Spirit, it is God's will that we keep ourselves pure and holy. Therefore he forbids all unchaste acts, gestures, words, thoughts, desires, and whatever may entice us to unchastity.

### Song of The Month


This month's song is Psalm 100. We will be learning to sing this in parts on a Sunday morning soon! You can hear the tune on YouTube here:


## All People That on Earth Do Dwell
