We have written about the major goal of the Fundraising Campaign: the Restoration of the tower and replacing the southern roof. Another goal is to reinstate Youth Ministry at St James' as we wish to welcome and nurture the next generation.

We plan to hire a part-time Children and Youth Ministry Coordinator. This new role will help us connect with young families, build relationships, and invite children and youth into the life of faith at St. James.

The coordinator will lead engaging programs, support Sunday School and youth activities, and reach out to young people at St. Stephen's and St. Paul's, inviting them into shared ministry. This five-year investment lays the foundation for long-term growth in our ministry with young people.
