Treasury Notes: July 18

My regrets for not being more prompt with updates this month. The 2025 budget forecasted regular Sunday donations of \$350,000, we just past the midpoint where we should have received \$175,000. I'm pleased to report that we received donations of \$184,647 exceeding the target by almost \$10,000!! Moreover, in this time frame we also had donations of \$10,500 for the Slay the Debt Challenge!! We've done very well to date, and I have every confidence that we will continue to do well for the remainder of the year. In week one of July, we received donations of \$3,150 against a July weekly goal of \$2,200. A great start to the month. - Warren Everett

The Cathedral is thrilled to be hosting the acclaimed Chapel Choir of Pembroke College, Cambridge, UK, for a service of Choral Evensong and an evening concert at the end of July. Celebrated for presenting "life-enhancing performances," the 30-person mixed-voice choir has spent a decade under the leadership of widely-respected organist and BBC Broadcaster **Anna Lapwood**. After the tour, Anna will conclude her tenure at Pembroke to pursue her career as an international performer full-time. Do plan to attend Evensong, the concert, or both!

Conclude your day with this service of sung evening prayer. This blend of Psalms, prayers and hymns showcases the best of our Anglican choral tradition. The Chapel Choir leads the service with music by Cecilia MacDowall, Herbert Howells, and Sir Edward Elgar.

The Chapel Choir presents a concert under the rich acoustics of the Cathedral dome, featuring a rich diversity of works including *Vigilate* by William Byrd, various works by Eric Whitacre, and a few works by Canadian composer, Eleanor Daley, among many others. This will be a spectacular performance.
