

1	HEAD (What We Learn or Believe) To understand fully what was taught on Sunday, who the Holy Spirit is, and how Scripture describes His role within the Triune God, what have you come to learn? John 14:15–17; Genesis 1:2; Acts 1:8; Colossians 2:9 Reflect on how the Holy Spirit is not just a force or feeling, but God Himself.	
2	From reflecting on what you heard, why is it essential to understand that the Holy Spirit is both powerful and personal? Ezekiel 36:25–27; Ephesians 4:30; 1 Corinthians 12:11 How does knowing the Spirit can be grieved or make decisions change your view of Him?	
3	Can you explain what it means, "that the Holy Spirit glorifies Christ in evangelism, conversion, and discipleship?" John 16:6–8, 14; Acts 2:36–37; John 3:5–8 How does this help you understand the Spirit's mission?	
4	In your own words, give examples of how the believer's life is transformed by being "in Christ" through the work of the Holy Spirit.  Ephesians 1:4, 7; Romans 8:9; John 1:12–13  What are the blessings of union with Christ that the Spirit applies to believers?	
5	HANDS (What We Do or Practice) How can you rely more fully on the Holy Spirit when sharing your faith with others? Acts 1:8; 1 Peter 3:15; John 16:8 Think about practical ways to trust the Spirit's role in evangelism.	
6	In what ways can you cultivate sensitivity to the Spirit's guidance in your daily decisions? Romans 8:9; 2 Corinthians 4:6; John 16:13 Are there moments this past week where you've sensed the Spirit leading you?	
7	FEET (Where We Go or How We Live It Out) What is one area of your life where you need the Spirit's empowerment to live more like Christ? Ephesians 5:18; Galatians 5:22–23; John 16:14 Identify a specific character trait or relationship where you can grow.	
8	How are you currently serving or building up the body of Christ using the gifts or equipping the Spirit has given you?  1 Corinthians 12:4–11; Ephesians 4:11–13 Are there ways you can step into a new area of service or deepen your current ministry?
