PENASCO MISSION TRIP - The group left early Friday morning, July 18th and returning July 26th. Please keep them in your prayers for safe travels and a successful VBS.

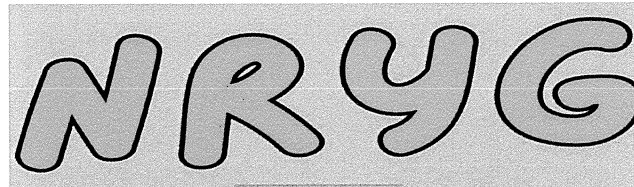
OAK GROVE CHURCH OF CHRIST GOSPEL MEETING

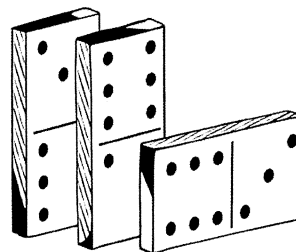
