Words from Pastor Chris

One year ago, you approved a new NextGen Pastor position and chose a search committee to find the next person to come lead our student ministry. I have said a few times over the last few weeks that it has been a trying year. While many fellow pastors warned me about how difficult our search would be, I wasn't quite prepared for how difficult it ended up being. While we had some good candidates, nothing ever seemed to materialize. While it was easy to become discouraged, we kept praying along with many of you. The circumstances surrounding Bro. Brad's coming to our church are truly a testament to God ordering our steps. Looking back on all the candidates that didn't work out, we can easily see why now. God had chosen Brad.

As Brad begins ministry in earnest over the next few weeks, there are a few things that I would ask everyone to do. Number one, I ask that you commit to pray for him and his family every day. Pray first that God would protect their family from the spiritual attacks that will look to derail ministry. Pray for their family as they transition to a new church. Pray for them as they begin to build relationships with our young people and volunteers. Pray that they will be able to quickly earn the trust of those same people. Pray that God would help them to navigate each challenge that will come from such a transition and ministry.

Secondly, I would love everyone to work hard at making them feel welcome. They are now forever part of the FBC Florala family. Go out of your way to make conversation, give them an encouraging word, and if possible, invite them for a meal.

Third, I want to encourage you to pray about how you can assist them in ministry. Youth and children's ministry requires many people in a church of our size. While we have many great volunteers, if there is some way you can pitch in, then, do. As Brad identifies specific needs over time, he will need willing vessels to help carry out the ministry. You have shown how committed you are to our young people by approving this position but let's not expect Bro. Brad to have to do all the work on his own. It will take each of us.

As I close, I want to say a special thank you to our search committee. Wade Farmer, Donnie Clark, Brittany Klawitter, and Laura Ashley Radney have served so faithfully. They have poured through resumes, met multiple times, interviewed multiple people, prayed multiple prayers, and experienced the roller coaster of emotion that comes with such responsibility. If you see them, please be sure to say thank you for their service to get us to this point.

VBS is such a special time in my life, and probably the life of many of you. It is a highlight of many kids' summers. Again, thank you and rest up, because planning for next year will be right around the corner!



SUNDAY SCHOOL

I challenge you to read through these reasons and decide which of them apply to your Sunday school class. Then take action. These reasons came from an article from Ken Braddy on why he believes the Sunday Schools in many churches are declining. Ken Braddy currently serves as the Director of Sunday School & Network Partnerships for Lifeway Christian Resources. From 2010 through 2021, he was the managing director of Lifeway's adult ongoing Bible studies such as Explore The Bible & Bible Studies For Life.

Reason 1: Churches are not starting new groups regularly.

Reason 2: Groups are not working prospect lists.

"If you starve anything long enough, it will die." This is especially true of Sunday School or small groups that are designed to reach new people.

Reason 3: Teachers are not delivering quality, engaging, and interactive Bible studies.

Lecture is the dominant form of teaching in our Sunday Schools, and Sunday School has a reputation for being boring.

Reason 4: We've forgotten the true mission of Sunday School.

Sunday School is a foundational strategy for making disciples. That's the core mission: make disciples.

Reason 5: People are not inviting others to attend their group's Bible study.

The invitation of a friend is the #1 reason why people attend a Bible study.

Reason 6: Many Sunday School groups (adults) are just too large.

Large groups will not produce disciples in the same way that smaller groups will. Jesus' model was to work with a group of 12 and a group of 3.

Larger groups are places where people can hide. It's difficult to "stick" in a large group because you simply are not missed like you are in a smaller group.

Reason 7: We no longer set growth goals.

Reason 8: We are not visiting people in the home.


Reason 9: Sunday School is hard work.
