We believe each stage represents a unique part of the journey, with its own joys, challenges, and opportunities for service. As a church, our goal is to walk alongside each person in their faith, encouraging each other to take the next steps toward a deeper relationship with Jesus and a life that reflects His love. This pathway is meant to nurture that growth—not to define it—helping all of us to better follow, lead, and serve with humility and love.
