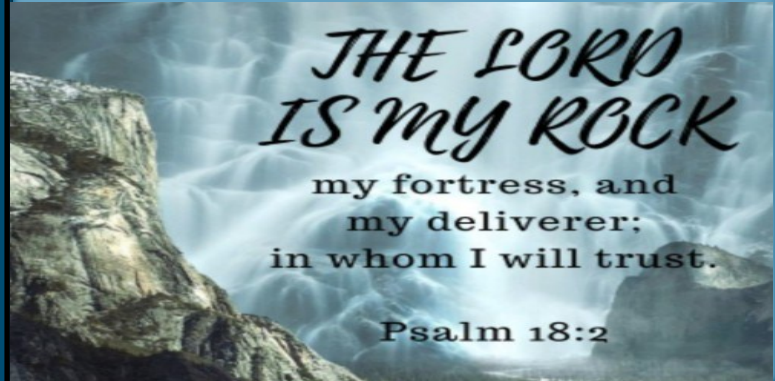

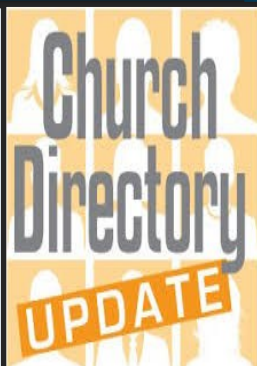

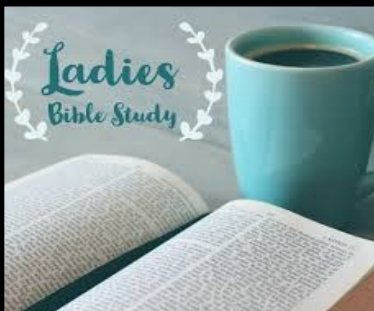

Living Life to the Excess

We live in a culture that celebrates more. More money. More success. More stuff. More entertainment. More pleasure. We are constantly told that having more will finally make us happy. But Scripture tells a different story, one that calls us to live lives of contentment, discipline, and purpose rather than excess.

King Solomon had access to every luxury imaginable. In Ecclesiastes 2, Solomon said, "Whatever my eyes desired I did not keep from them. I kept my heart from no pleasure... Then I considered all that my hands had done... and behold, all was vanity and a striving after wind" (Eccl. 2:10-11). Despite his indulgence, Solomon found it all empty.

Jesus warned about the dangers of excess, saying, "Take care, and be on your guard against all covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions" (Luke 12:15). He then told the parable of the rich fool who built bigger barns to store all his goods but died that very night. His problem wasn't wealth, it was living only for himself and ignoring God.

As followers of Christ, we are called to live with eternal perspective. Paul wrote, "If we have food and clothing, with these we will be content" (1 Timothy 6:8). He didn't say it's wrong to have blessings, but he reminded us that godliness with contentment is great gain (v. 6). It is a warning not to chase worldly success while neglecting our souls.

Living in excess doesn't just apply to money. It can be about time, entertainment, food, social media, even ambition. When we fill our lives to the brim, we leave little room for God, service, rest, or reflection. The danger is not just in what we have, but in what we value. Jesus calls us to live simple, generous, self-controlled lives. When we do, we find the kind of peace and joy that excess can never offer.
