We're Going Digital!

This will be the last issue of the MBC monthly newsletter. Yes, you read that correctly. It has become increasingly difficult to justify producing a monthly newsletter in light of not only the cost but more importantly its lack of use. More and more people are turning to our online calendar for dates of upcoming events. More and more when people say they



didn't know about something and we ask if they saw it in the newsletter, the answer is, "Well, no". Most people carry a cell phone today and have instant access to not only the dates of church activities and information about them, but also contact information for fellow congregants. Another consideration is the cost. The newsletter is costly. Every copy costs money and every issue takes several hours to produce. We've added a part-time administrative assistant, and they are both hustling to keep up as ministry activity increases.

A fair question is, "Is there a better option?". We think there is a better option, a weekly email. The office can easily send out an email with the dates and information about church events, and at no cost. It will be less labor intensive to produce due to the lack of need for time spent formatting, looking for background art, etc. It just makes sense when all things are considered to move to digital communication.

What this means for you is that the **MBC** church app will be your go-to source for information about what's happening at MBC. The office will also print copies of the weekly updates for those who don't use cell phones or computers. Printed copies will be available Sunday mornings at the church Information Center (aka Welcome

Center). At Pastor Kevin's previous church, they went this route, and while



it took a little while to adjust, it worked well. To get the MBC church app go to your app store and search for the <u>Tithely Church App</u> or scan the QR code to the right.

The digital move doesn't end with the newsletter. For the same reasons, August will be the last month we produce the Sunday morning bulletin. The sermon outline and discussion questions page will still be available Sunday morning for those who use them.

The **Breeze app** for the new church software will contain the directory. *This is different than the MBC church app*, it is an app that works with the software the church is using for records, for ministry planning, scheduling, etc. It will replace the Instant Church Directory many of you are using as an online directory. To get the app go to <u>breeze church management</u> in your app store and install the app. Contact the church office for login help.

Some of you remember the bulletins and newsletters made with a typewriter and mimeograph machine, and paper directories. You survived the changes of moving to where we are now and you will adjust to this one. Change isn't always easy, but it is inevitable. One thing you can count on not to change is our Lord. Hebrews 13:8 (*NASB95*) says, "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever." Hang on to this as well, we will not change in our commitment to hold to the Word of God in all our teaching.

Over the last several months, the Missions Ministry has been interviewing and exploring possible candidates for support after a couple of our missionaries needed to leave the field. We are very excited to announce that God has led us to two new families! First we introduce a family that Darryl and Kim Wheeler have known for a very long time and brought to our attention. Heather and Brian Dellamater (and their daughter) serve with Global Outreach International in Kenya. In 2017 they moved there to establish Kijani Farms. They built a home and a successful farm using "farming God's way" techniques. They currently have 30-40 staff members and serve 916 children. Their work includes bringing clean water, productive agriculture, education, health care, and job creation and training to the villages. They also have ample opportunities for evangelism and discipleship. We are excited to watch God work as they continue developing Kijani Farm. Their ultimate goal is to step away when the nationals are able to carry on without them.

The second family is Josh and Megan Smith and their children. Josh practiced in Marshfield as an ENT physician until God called them to meet physical and spiritual need in Guatemala. Their family is currently being prepared for the mission field through an 18 month process with TEAM. Josh is on the board of IGN (Impacting Guatemala Network) which was started by our missionary Oscar Chiquito. They also donated the roasted coffee beans which we offered as a fundraiser for the Retreat and Training Center a couple of years ago. Megan and Josh have had amazing things happen as they obediently followed God's call to missions. We can't wait for you to hear their story!
