Our members and friends posted signs around town, put up the signs on church property, pitched the tent, borrowed tables from Bethesda, set up tables and chairs, made baked goods, bought food from Henry's, lined up someone to make potato salad, made a slide show in the sanctuary, ushered, sold tickets, greeted diners, served food, cut watermelon, enlisted the Pork Producers, grilled pork chops, and perhaps most Pastor David Fleener importantly, cleaned up afterward! It requires a genuine sacrifice of time, energy, and for some, money, to put on this event.

And there are many rewards to having such a long-running, well-regarded event.

I'm not just talking about the money raised, although that is worth mentioning. After Bread for the World dues, we may have close to two mortgage payments on our beautiful sanctuary. The goodwill this event has created for our little congregation is worth at least as much as the revenue we generate. And most importantly, it opens the door for the gospel of Jesus Christ, which finds its way into hearts through these relationships.

If you haven't helped with the BBQ in the past, I encourage you to do so. Many hands make for light work. It is remarkable what we can accomplish when we all come together.

I look forward to continuing this long-running tradition with you.

- ** **Finance**: Building Fund is staying caught up. We are down about \$22,800. Last year at this time we were down about \$26,000. Grant was able to get a statement for Linda for WELCA. An account has been set up for Radio Ministry.

Summary:

This Shalom reporting is through June/25, with a combined General and Building Funds deficit of \$16,060. The deficit is primarily due to Jan-June offerings under-budget by \$26,538. The General/Bldg Funds balance is about \$123,000, down from \$139,000 at the end of December/24.

Vote to End Hunger

Bread for the World's Vote to End Hunger campaign secured more than 1,400 pledges from Americans committing to cast their vote to end hunger. Launched in advance of the 2024 election season, the campaign employed a comprehensive multichannel media strategy. The primary objective was to inspire Christians to engage in thoughtful discernment when selecting candidates, focusing on their potential to make meaningful changes in ending hunger both domestically and globally.

The campaign was rooted in a biblical understanding of governance and social responsibility. Drawing inspiration from scriptural examples of leaders like Joseph and Nehemiah, the campaign emphasized the Christian calling to pray for elected leaders who prioritize justice, compassion, and the needs of people who are marginalized.



GWOH NEW

Once again, it's time to make book bags for LWR. Please pick up a bag, or two or, three or more. Fill with the required items and return them to church. If you wish to help with shipping costs, put your donation in the "List envelope" and return with bags. Last year LWR sent 140,117 school kits to 16 countries around the world. Recently LWR has started



sending material resources to those in need in the United States. So far, due to hurricanes, 9,494 school kits have been given to children in Florida, North Carolina and Tennessee. Thanks for letting Our Hands be God's Work. Coordinator Needed A member of Shalom has given a very generous gift to WELCA to fund the NEWBORN KITS we give to Global Health Ministries. For the NB ministry to continue, we need someone to step up and coordinate this project. The coordinator would ensure that all needed items are acquired, purchased, or donated; assemble the kits and pack them for shipping. (Talked to Judy Hoffman for specifics)



Our acronym, WELCA, is often misunderstood. I think most of us know that it stands for Women of the ELCA, but most often it is associated with that group of women who meet on a regular basis, have a Bible Study, conduct a business meeting, discuss possible projects, have lunch and go home. 
