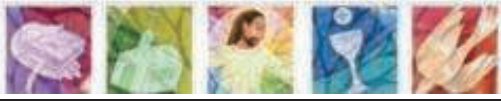

SPN Parish Council Holy Moment Thought...

"MY PEACE I GIVE TO YOU."

Jesus said to his disciples: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid. (John 14: 27). Jesus gives a special peace, the Shalom, to His disciples and to us present-day disciples.

This is the Peace of Christ. It is radically different from the peace of the world. The world claims peace when there is no war, when the stock market and the economy are good. When the family is not at each other's throat, or everyone is in good health. The peace of Jesus is unlike Pax Romana, the imposed peace of the Roman Empire on conquered people. It is the Peace through the strength of Jesus.

What is the peace that Jesus Christ gives us? What is His special type of peace? When one experiences the fullness of the Peace of Christ, he or she becomes able to withstand the hardships of this world *without fear*. The martyrs, who felt immense joy and peace at the moment of their execution serve as a stunning and tangible example of this Peace of Christ in action. The apostles Paul and Barnabas "strengthened the spirits of the disciples and exhorted them to persevere in the faith, saying, 'It is necessary for us to undergo many hardships to enter the Kingdom of God.'" (Acts 14: 22). Saint Padre Pio shared his motto, "Pray, hope and don't worry".

How do we accept this peace? It is our task to *receive* this Peace of Christ...accept it...cultivate it...understand it...grow it and most importantly, as a true believer, to share it with others. We are called to comfort all who are living with a worldly view of peace; one that allows huge burdens of distress when worldly peace is disrupted or

distant from us. Even in the sporadic moments of temporary worldly peace, we feel the tenuousness and anticipate the loss of this kind of peace.

Not so with the blessed Peace of Christ, this is a special gift of the Holy Spirit! When the Holy Spirit takes residence in your heart, He brings the Peace of Christ. The Holy Spirit brings love, joy, patience and other sweet gifts to those who believe and accept the Peace of Christ!

Please consider saying the following prayer...**O merciful God, fill our hearts, we pray, with the graces of your Holy Spirit; with love, joy, peace, patience, gentleness, goodness, faithfulness, humility and self-control. Teach us to love those who hate us; to pray for those who despitefully use us; that we may be the children of your love, our Father, who makes the sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust. In adversity, grant us grace to be patient; in prosperity keep us humble; may we guard the door of our lips and seek after heavenly things through Jesus Christ our Lord. AMEN.**

Food Drive to Benefit the OPEN LINK

Summer is when the most help is needed with food donations. We will be having a FOOD DRIVE August 2nd to the 10th. Bins will be at each door of the church.

The Open Link's **Community Food Pantry** is designed to provide food to local families (**our neighbors**) who do not currently have the financial means to meet their nutritional needs. In addition to food, the pantry is able to provide local families in need with other basic necessities such as infant formula, diapers, toiletries, cleaning supplies, and paper products (when available).

Starting July 1, 2025 families will be able to access the Food Pantry TWICE a month!

Summer Kids Meal Program? Each summer, families in our community struggle to feed their children because those kids are no longer receiving free or reduced lunch once school is out.

During the summer of 2024, The Open Link served 17,668 meals to children throughout the Valley. That number is expected to increase this summer.

The **Meals on Wheels** (MOW), also known as Home Delivered Meals (HDM), provides nutritious meals, friendly visits, and safety checks to our homebound neighbors.

The Open Link provides a daily **Community Meal** where people can go and get a nutritious meal served hot in-person Monday through Friday at 12:00pm.

The Garden, started in 2024 is their newest initiative, the garden provides fresh, nutritious produce for pantry customers and Center participants.

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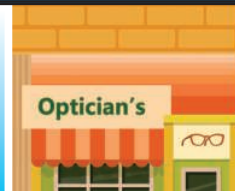
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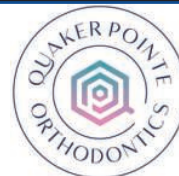
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
