

FAITH Πίστις "pistis"

This word means "belief" or "trust" though it can also mean "faithfulness."

Faith can refer to the act of believing. The NT speaks about faith in God (1 Pet. 1:21; Heb. 6:1) and faith in Jesus (Acts 3:16; 1 Tim. 3:13) 'For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.'


