

## Romans Adoption

patria potestas - "the father's power"

Two Steps of Roman Adoption

1st Step: mancipatio (emancipation)

2nd Step: vindicatio

## 4 Results of Romans adoption

- 1. The adopted person lost all rights to his old family and gained all rights in his new family.
- 2. The adopted person became the full heir to his new father's estate even if there were other sons.
- 3. The adopted person's old life was completely wiped out.
- 4. In the eyes of Roman law and society it was as if the adopted person was literally and completely the son of his new father in every sense.

#### "ABBA"

- > Not a Swedish pop band from the 80's
- > You have a new adoption. A new inheritance. A new IDENTITY!
- Mark 14:36: "And He said, 'Abba, Father all things are possible for you. Remove this cup from me. Yet not what I will, but what you will."
- Solution Gal. 4:6: "And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, 'Abba! Father!"
- > Rom.8:16: "The <u>Spirit Himself</u> bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God."

- > 1 John 4:13: "By this we know that we abide in Him and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit."
- 2 Cor.1:21-22: "And it is God who establishes us with you in Christ, and has anointed us, and who has also put His seal on us and given us His Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee."
- > Eph.1:13-14: "In Him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in Him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory."
- The Holy Spirit confirms our adoption and therefore we can have confidence we are children of God.
