



Small Groups

In just a few weeks, a new round of small groups will start and I highly encourage each one in our church to take this opportunity to get connected and grow deeper. There's something for everyone.

This season we have five groups forming which all meet in the Crossroads Center. Groups begin August 13 and run through about Thanksgiving.



One group will meet on Tuesday mornings, 10 AM, for those who don't drive in the evenings. Eddie Hagar will lead a study of the Life of the Apostle Paul using a video curriculum in the Asbury Room of the Crossroads Center.



My name is Sara Fordyce, and I volunteer as the Chairperson for our Finance Committee.

For our August edition of Generosity Matters (the

little financial corner of the First Methodist Crestview monthly newsletter), I'd like to share a few reminders about exciting things happening early in the month of August:

IMPORTANT REMINDER #1: The Finance Committee is hosting a multi-session financial education series that will be open to everyone.

Session 1 of "Living a Generous Life: Faith & Finances" will be held in the Crossroads Center on Tuesday, **August 5**, 2025 at 5:30pm. A light dinner will be provided (Pounders Hawaiian Grill) and nursery will be offered.

Guest Speakers, Terri Turner (Executive Director of the Methodist Foundation

since 1991), Sara Fordyce (Financial Advisor since 2002) and Angie Woodward (CPA since 1998) will be sharing insights about faith and finances.

IMPORTANT REMINDER #2: CHANGE FOR CHANGE: It's not too late to participate in our churchwide endeavor to make a change in our debt balances. We currently have 2 outstanding loan balances. Our disaffiliation loan balance is just under \$88,000 and our Crossroads Center mortgage is just under \$228,000.

We are committed to getting our church out of debt as quickly as possible and believe that a CHANGE FOR CHANGE project is a small way to get everyone involved.


