Next Week's Sermon Text - Luke 7:18-23

How Do I Prepare for the Lord's Supper?

At Chapel, we believe that it is a valuable spiritual practice to prepare our hearts ahead of time for the celebration of the Lord's Supper. This week we encourage you to consider these questions as you prepare to receive the sacrament.

1 - Am I living in union with Jesus? (1 Corinthians 11:27-29)

Examine your life, confess your sins, and repent of them. By doing this, you are admitting your need of Jesus' forgiving and renewing grace. Recall the truths of the gospel and rejoice in what Jesus has done for you and is doing in you.

If you are struggling with a particular sin, ask the Holy Spirit to motivate and strengthen you in overcoming the sin, even as you participate in the sacrament.

2 - Am I living in communion with fellow believers? (Matthew 5:21-26)

The Bible calls God's people to habits of repentance, forgiveness, and reconciliation. If you have sinned against a fellow believer, repent of your sin and seek their forgiveness. If a fellow believer has sinned against you, seek to forgive and reconcile with them.

You can't control the responses of others, but do everything in your power to achieve peace with other Christians before you come to participate in the sacrament.

The Session has decided to begin incorporating a **dedicated time of Confession of Sin** into our worship services. Confession has always been a theme in our worship, but this is an opportunity to distinctly confess our sins and sinfulness as a body, which we believe is a biblical element of worship. Each time of confession will be accompanied by an Assurance of Forgiveness in some form, reflecting our joyful belief that God's grace is greater than our sin. We will confess our sins together at different times during the service, depending on the overall flow and purposes of the particular service.
