
PRODUCE SHARING TABLE BEGINS!

in Greater Milwaukee Synod seeking to welcome, include, celebrate, and advocate for our LGBTQIA+ siblings, both in our worshipping communities and in our neighborhoods. We are looking for people here on the RIC Ministry Team to step up and get involved in the synod's Authentic Diversity work.

Someone asked. "What's all involved?"

... here's an outline of what we're doing:

What is GMS's RIC Ministry Team?

A gathering of people from Reconciling in

Christ worshipping communities and others

The Authentic Diversity plan is a 2-year cooperative program among all the diversity groups in Greater Milwaukee Synod. It has 3 major phases. You can be a part of just one phase or participate in all the phases.

Listening Phase: Starts on Saturday, August 16 with a full day training at Redeemer Lutheran, 19th and Wisconsin. Those trained will lead a four month (or so) listening campaign to assess where congregations are at and their viability for engaging in this work. Planning Phase: Starts in Winter/Spring 2026 with a full day training. Those trained will develop a framework and strategy for

Action Phase: Starts in Summer/Fall 2026. The plan is put into action and leaders engage with congregations to undertake the real work of becoming more authentically diverse.

Please consider being a part of this work.

Those who engage in this portion of the work - the Listening Phase will need to be at the training on August 16. After that, it's a multi-month commitment, but the work we do together will lead to improving the ministry of all our congregations. Big ask. Important ministry.
