# Sermon Outline "Identity Theft II" 7.27.25

Judges 6:11-16 & 2 Corinthians 10:3-5

#### 1. Strongholds: What Are They?

- **Key verse:** 2 Corinthians 10:3–4 *God's weapons have divine power to demolish strongholds.*
- Stronghold (ochýrōma): a fortress of lies; a prisoner locked by deception.
- The **door is unlocked**, but we don't leave because we **believe** we're trapped.

## 2. A Picture from Wreck-It Ralph

- Ralph is labeled the "bad guy" for 30 years.
- The lie: "I can't change."
- The turn: he steps out, chooses love, sacrifice, and friendship—identity shifts.

### 3. A Picture from Scripture: Gideon (Judges 6)

- Gideon's belief: "I'm the weakest... the least." (6:15)
- God's word: "Mighty warrior."
- Truth: What God calls you is greater than what you call you.
- Under God's guidance, Gideon leads and delivers Israel.

#### 4. How God Demolishes Strongholds

- Capture every lie/thought and bring it to God.
- Replace lies with God's truth (Scripture, prayer, worship).
- Speak words that agree with God's promises.
- Walk in community (church, accountability).
- Act on your new identity (obedience, serving, loving).

#### 4. Our Mission as Lakeside

- Help people hear the Gospel so lies lose power.
- **Do good**: feed, love, serve—so the Gospel can take root.
- Pray for those struggling; encourage them to speak truth.
- God calls us, like Gideon, "mighty warriors."
