week 1 team leaving this Saturday will be building fuel efficient stoves that make an amazing difference in the health of the families and the quality of water in the villages due to less smoke inhalation and fewer trees being cut down. Our week 2 team that leaves August 9 will be building latrines. We take our toilets for granted, but in many parts of the world people still do not have adequate access to latrines. This leads to all kinds of preventable sickness and to the contamination of the drinking water. Keep these groups in your prayers over the next two weeks.

Marriage By Design August 27-September 10 6:15pm, Jones Residence


Join Jeff and Susan in their home for a three week workshop on building a


