

# Pastor's Corner

Going back to school can be an exciting time for teachers and students, and lots of parents are eager to return to the normal routine a regular school day brings. That dependable, regular routine of the school day helps students know what to expect when each day begins; and knowing what to expect helps students trust that their teachers and parents have their best interest at heart. It's no different at church for the start of a new Sunday School year. Kids returning to worship and class can look forward to seeing familiar faces - of both friends and teachers - and trust that Sunday School will be an enjoyable, safe place to learn about Jesus and grow in God's love.

First developed in England in the late 1700's in an effort to educate poor children, Sunday School quickly became part of the regular routine for children in the United States. For the last two centuries, millions upon millions of children have learned the basics of the Christian faith in churches on Sunday mornings. They've learned the stories of the Old and New Testaments. They've learned how to treat each other in the same way God has treated them: with love, kindness, and forgiveness (which, I might add, don't come "naturally"). Think for a moment about the significance this "lowly" movement has had, and its impact upon our nation. Where would our country be today, were the Church not blessed by so many willing and faithful Sunday School teachers? How can we thank these women and men properly, for giving so lovingly of themselves to so many children, that they might grow in God's love and be filled with the fruit of the Holy Spirit? Truly, words fail.

In his little book, *Life Together*, Dietrich Bonhoeffer wrote: "What may appear weak and trifling to us may be great and glorious to God." I think this is exactly the case with Sunday School. So many, many children have been so richly blessed, because the people of the Church cared and were concerned to share Jesus' love. So, when you see a Sunday School teacher, at Salem, or anywhere you go, don't overlook the fact that you have met one of God's most precious and important means of working in this world!

# The Salem Mission Team and Sunday School will again work together to collect school supplies for the Lutheran World Relief School Kit project.

The collection tote and poster will be set-up in the church narthex beginning on August 18th, 2024 - "Rally Sunday".

We will be collecting supplies through August and September and then assemble the kits during the Sunday School hour in late September.

If you are able to help out by purchasing any of the supplies listed it will be greatly appreciated. If anyone wishes to make a monetary donation to the LWR School Kit project the Salem Mission Team will use the donation to purchase the items for the kits. Checks can be made out to Salem Lutheran Church Women with a note "for the LWR School Kits".

Each LWR School Kit contains the following items:

- (4) 70 sheet notebooks of wide or college ruled paper-not loose leaf paper
- (1) 30 centimeter ruler or a ruler with centimeters on one side & inches on the other
- (1) Pencil sharpener
- (1) Pair of blunt scissors (safety scissors with embedded steel blades work well)
- (5) Unsharpened #2 pencils with erasers
- (5) Black or blue ballpoint pens (no gel ink)
- (1) Box of 24 crayons
- (1) 2-1/2" eraser



August is a great time to purchase school kit items as most of these items are on sale in August and early September.

Please note that the items in the kits are very specific per Lutheran World Relief guidelines so that each student receives the same supplies.
