

After three months back in France we look upon these first months of our second term with great joy and praise for all the Lord has done and allowed us to do!

On the 15th of April, we moved into our new apartment in Aix and started meeting there, after renting a restaurant for our Sunday services. This was a blessing for us to move in only one month after our return because it is very diffcult to find housing in Aix-en-Provence. Immediatly, we started working on creating our church legally after having held the initial business meetings. By God's grace, this went faster than expected and we received the validation of our churches' creation just two weeks ago which by french standards was quick! Last week, we finally were able to open our bank account and we are excited to start the search for a permanent meeting place.
