We confess that we have not loved you with our whole heart. We have not done your will, we have not always loved our neighbors as you would like us to, and we have not heard the cry of the needy. Forgive us, we pray.

Open our minds and our hearts to hear your guidance and your wisdom. Free us for joyful obedience, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

On the night in which he gave himself up for us, he took bread, gave thanks to you, broke the bread, gave it to his disciples, and said:
"Take, eat. This is my body which is given for you.
Do this in remembrance of me."

When the supper was over, he took the cup, gave thanks to you, gave it to his disciples, and said: "Drink from this, all of you; this is my blood of the new covenant, poured out for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins.

Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me." Take and Drink
