

Additional Questions for Hebrews 4:1-16 (Aug 10, 2025)

One of themes of the book of Hebrews is the superiority of Christ, and Hebrews 4:14 can be considered as a thesis statement of the book. Beginning with 4:14 and continuing through the middle of chapter 10, the author focuses on the high priesthood of Jesus and His marvelous work of bringing mankind to God and giving eternal life.

Pray that He would give you ears to hear as you study His Word and that He would show you where you may have become dull of hearing.

Read Hebrews 4:14-5:14

1. Read Heb. 4:14-5:14 and write down 4-5 observations, repeated words or phrases, O.T. quotes, commands, warnings, lists, etc. Try to summarize this section.
2. From Heb. 4:14, what titles does the author use to refer to Jesus? What action is attributed to Him, and what is its significance?
3. Since these are true about Jesus, what are believers instructed to do? Find one or two other references in Hebrews chapters 1-3 that provide similar encouragement.
4. According to Hebrews 4:15, for what reason can believers hold fast to their confession?
5. From verse 16, what does Jesus' role as the great high priest enable His followers to do, how are they to do it, what do they receive when they do it, and when does that happen
