Dylan Debrick was recently baptized into Christ after studying with Jim, but was out of town last Sunday.

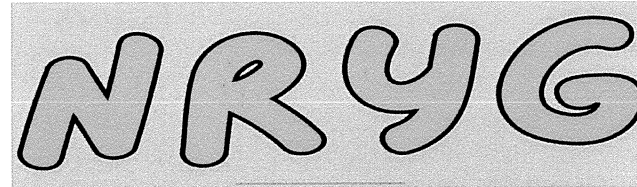

Delores Reazola - Has kidney failure and is in the process of scheduling a kidney transplant.

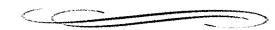
Jim Kenton - A good friend of Tom Freeman, is critically ill in the hospital in Hamilton, Tx.
