The 98 Campus is equipped with a hearing assistance system. Receivers are at the tech booth. Please see the tech crew for assistance.

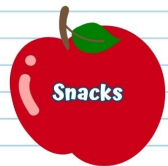

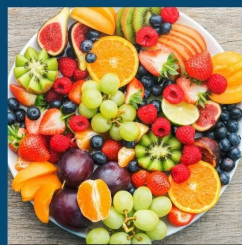
