Paul's point here in <i>Galatians 3</i> is that being circumcised and coming back under the burden of the old covenant system are nn

Gal 3:24 "Therefore the Law has become our tutor to lead us to Christ, so that we may be justified by faith."
The blessing of Abraham is superior to the law, because the law only had a t pand no redeeming power.
