Pastor's Corner

Joshua 1:8(a) "This book of the law shall not depart from you from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written therein."

Do we understand what it means to meditate? The biblical practice of meditation is about filling one's mind-with the Word of God!

The Hebrew word (transliterated) hagah, pronounced daw-gaw, means to growl, utter, speak, or muse. The biblical concept of meditation carries the image of a lion growling over, eating, and savoring its freshly caught prey. We so often think of the Word of God as a duty we must exercise. The Spirit teaches us that the Word of God is a meal to be savored and enjoyed.

Recall the signature instruction of Psalm 1:2 "But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night."
