"Coastlands" = Isle or Islands, and Countries

Who raised up one from the east?...

Who has performed and done [it]...

Isaiah 41:5-7

The coastlands saw [it] and feared...

Romans 1:18-25

Isaiah 41:8-10

But you, Israel, [are] My servant...

John 15:15 (NKJV) No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you.
