Some Helpful Info

Washrooms are available downstairs, via the front left of the sanctuary.

Nursery Area is in room 1, downstairs in the classroom corridor for parents and caregivers to use and remain with their infants.

The Toddler Room is in room 6. Drop off is available during Focus Sundays. During All-In Sundays, caregivers may use the room and remain with their toddlers. Children of all ages are more than welcome to remain in the sanctuary regardless of whether it is an all-in or focus Sunday.

Communion is celebrated weekly, using gluten-free bread.

Prayer Corner is offered during or after communion. Everyone is welcome to receive prayer. What you offer is held in confidence and afterwards released to God. Those praying won't touch you unless you are ok with it - typically, this is a hand on your shoulder. No one will follow-up with you about something that you've shared and prayed about unless you take initiative to approach them further.
