MINISTRY OF THE MONTH FOR AUGUST - PORCHLIGHT



Dear Lord, Bless the staff, clients, volunteers, and donors of PorchLight as they work together to help men experiencing homelessness to find stable housing. We know that their challenges are different as they face each day, but your Love never changes and we ask you to guide them as they struggle and celebrate with them when they succeed. Amen.

PorchLight (formerly Congregations for the Homeless) mission: "Partnering with men and the community to create a path from homelessness to stable living."

Porchlight has several programs to accomplish its mission. The information below is from their website <u>www.porchlightcares.org</u>.

*** The Emergency Men's Shelter (EMS), along with our Day Center, provides a safe, welcoming, resource-rich environment 24 hours a day every day of the year for men experiencing homelessness to rebuild their lives and obtain stable income and housing. Men in the enhanced shelter have access to safe sleeping accommodations, three nutritious meals a day, showers and laundry, storage, mail, haircuts, computers, etc. This low-barrier program serves 100+ men experiencing homelessness on the Eastside each day. In addition to on-site case management services, PorchLight offers on-site housing navigation, employment navigation, medical and dental care, and professional mental health and addiction supportive services.

***The **Rotating Shelter** (RS) is our night shelter operating from 7pm – 7am for 25 men at a given time experiencing homelessness. The RS provides a vibrant healthy community within host congregation spaces where men can rest, recover and rejuvenate. In addition to accessing case management supports, the men are able to obtain three meals a day, washers, dryers, showers, and haircuts. (The RS is staying at Newport Covenant Church during the month of August and SALC is helping to provide supplies for breakfast and hygiene.)

***PorchLight's **Housing Program** provides 65 units of Permanent Housing with Supportive Services in scattered sites for single men transitioning from homelessness to stable living. Men pay rent equal to 30% of their income. Each man is connected to our community of supports

through case managers, house managers, agency partners and other PorchLight staff. In 2024, our housing program had a 98% success rate of keeping men housed for two years or longer or graduating them to other permanent housing

***PorchLight also has an **Outreach Program**. If you see someone in need, please call us at 425-698-1295.

Exciting times for leadership in the ELCA!




At the recent Churchwide Assembly, a new Presiding Bishop was elected. Meet The Rev. Yehiel Curry in this video!
Before he became a pastor, then a bishop, then the chair of the Conference of Bishops, and now presiding bishop-elect, he was a social worker, then a teacher, then in sales. "I went from being a social worker to a teacher in the same community where I was helping those families, and in both cases, what I learned is passion is very important. And if you can align a person's passion with a need, then it doesn't feel like work sometimes.


"It wasn't until I was in the church that I said, 'I could do this for the rest of my life."

The Rev. Lucille "CeCee" Mills was elected Aug. 1 to serve a six-year term as secretary of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA). The election took place during the 2025 ELCA Churchwide Assembly being held July 28–Aug. 2 at the Phoenix (Ariz.) Convention Center. Mills was elected on the fifth ballot. There were 782 ballots cast, with 392 votes needed for an election. Mills received 404 votes to 378 votes for the Rev. Matthew Riegel, bishop of the ELCA West Virginia-Western Maryland Synod. Mills will be the first Black secretary of the ELCA. You can watch videos from all the CWA sessions here.
